Late C18 with C19 rear extension, front bay windows and entrance porch. Squared chalk with brick dressings, bay windows and porch, limewashed. Rendered stacks. Concrete pantile roof. Approximately square on plan: 2-room central entrance south front with original wing to rear left and later adjoining wing in angle. 2 storeys, 3 bays; symmetrical. High brick plinth, quoins and surrounds to openings. Projecting flat-roofed enclosed porch has round-headed entrance with two-fold half-glazed panelled doors, moulded impost band, hoodmould and painted moulded ashlar cornice. Canted bays to either side have recessed plate glass sashes (those to front with margin lights) under rubbed brick flat arches, stepped eaves and hipped roofs.
