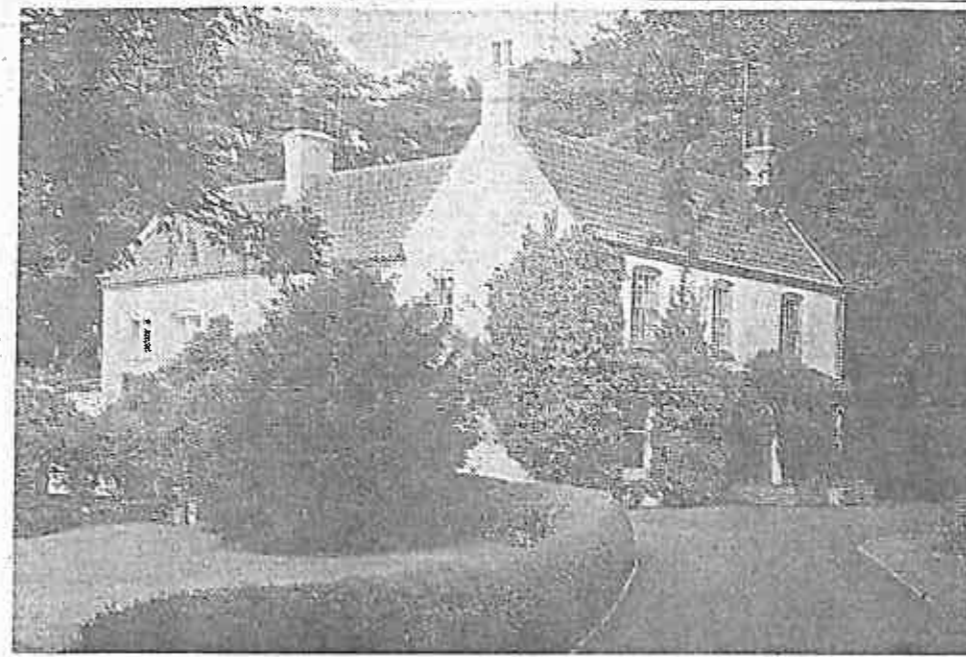


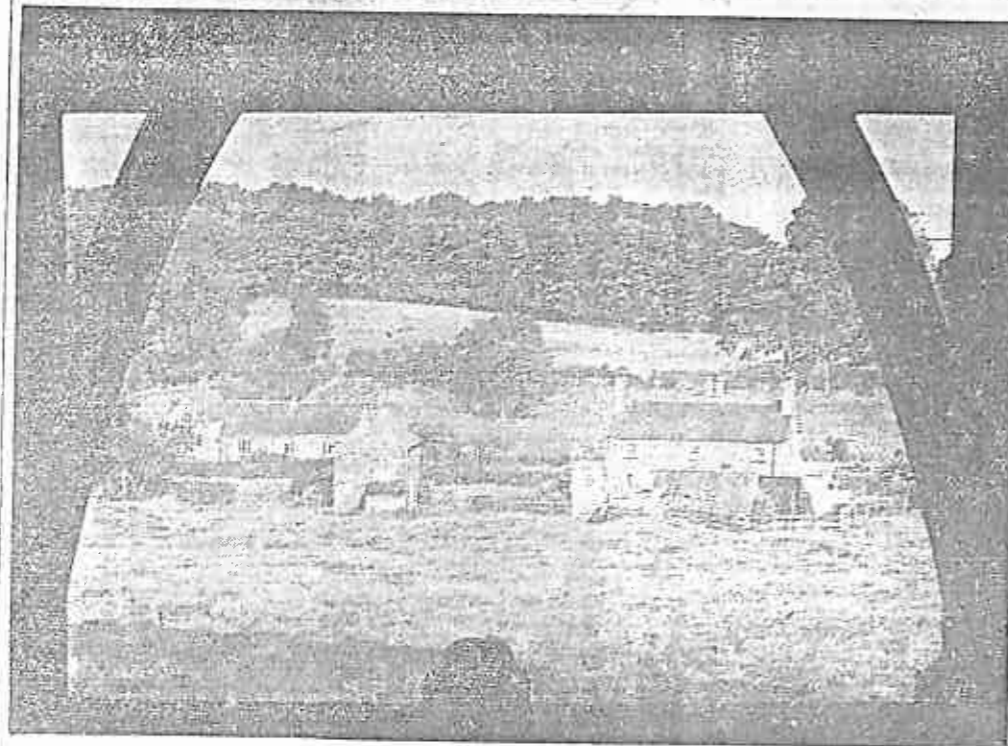
# Out and about ... OFF THE BEATEN TRACK



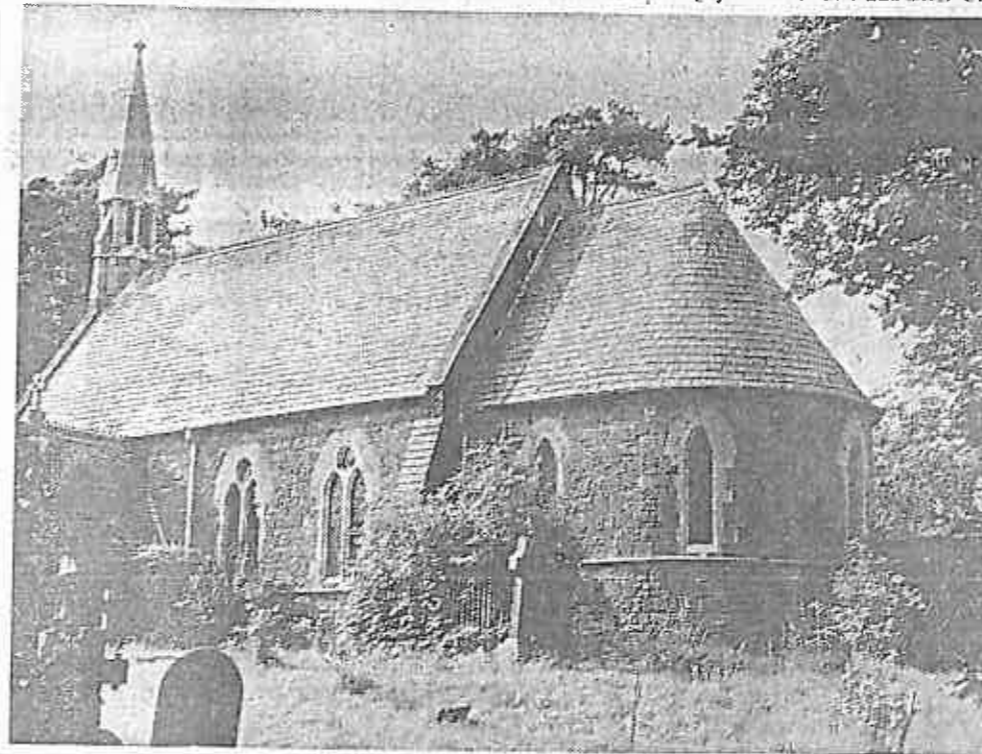
From the main road this footpath leads to Binbrook in the south west and Waltham in the north.

The church lychgate frames this rural picture.



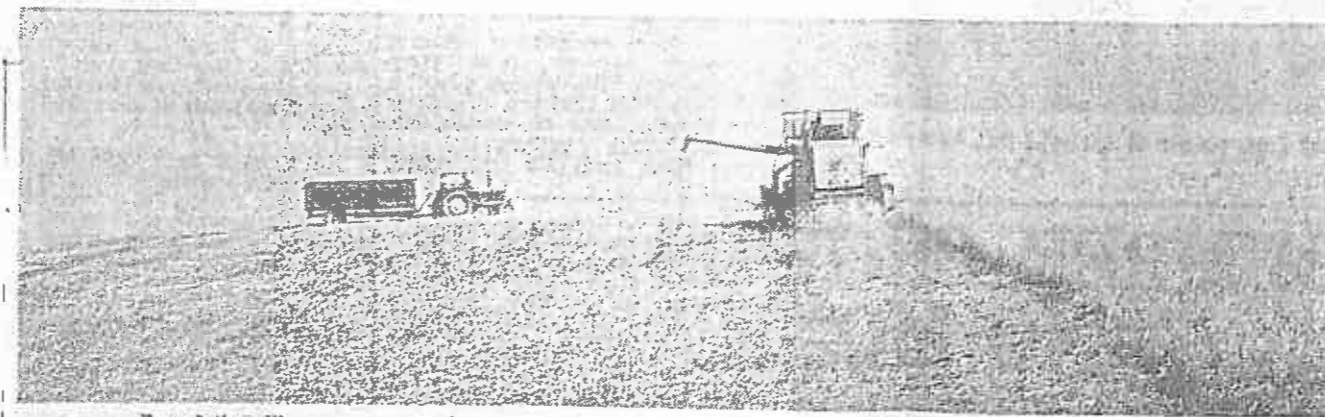
The church of All Saints, which was entirely rebuilt in 1862. Its octagonal bell turret contains one bell.
