Arms on record in the College of Arms.—Argent on a fesse engrailed between three eagles' heads erased azure as many martlets of the field.

Crest.—Upon a mount vert an unicorn passant regardant argent semée of estoiles azure armed maned and hooped or gorged with a collar of the third the dexter foot resting on a cross pattée gold.

Motto.—Quercus.

John Wright of Wold Newton and of Binbrooke Hall, both co. Lincoln (4th son of Edward Wright of North Kelsey, co. Lincoln, by Mary his wife, dau. of Joseph Mundy); born at North Kelsey, and bapt. there (by the Rev. John Mounsey, the Vicar) 9 July 1758; died at Binbrooke Hall 4 January, bur. at Wold Newton 11 January 1838. Memorial window. *Portrait in oils in the possession of Richard Caldicott Wright, his grandson.*

Margaret, dau. of Maurice Searle of Tetney, co. Lincoln, by Jane his wife, only surviving dau. of John Parsons of Wold Newton; born at Tetney, and bapt. there (by her uncle, the Rev. John Searle, the Vicar) 31 May 1761; marr. by licence at Wold Newton (by the Rev. John Grantham) 19 June 1788; died at Grove House, Caistor, co. Lincoln, 13 September, bur. at Wold Newton 18 September 1850. Memorial window. *Portrait in oils in the possession of Richard Caldicott Wright, her grandson.*

John Wright of Haugh Manor, co. Lincoln; born at Wold Newton 8 December, bapt. there (by the Rev. John Grantham) 11 December 1791; died at Haugh Manor 1 September, bur. at Haugh 4 September 1858. M.I. Will dated 21 August 1858, proved at Lincoln 23 October 1858, by Robert Kirke of Waltham, co. Lincoln, and John Horatio Wood of Humberstone, co. Lincoln, the Exors.

Anne, dau. of Samuel Wharton Kirke of Irby-on-Humber, co. Lincoln, formerly of Bonby, co. Lincoln, by Isabella Armstrong his wife; born at Irby-on-Humber 24 August, bapt. there 26 August 1819; marr. at Irby-on-Humber 8 September 1848; died at Louth, co. Lincoln, 13 May, bur. in the cemetery at Louth 17 May 1894.

Lincoln, 2 July, bur. in the cemetery at Louth 4 July 1894. Will dated 5 October 1875, proved at Lincoln 26 July 1894, by William George North, one of the Exors.

Isabella, born at Haugh 20 January, bapt. there (by the Rev. Paul Augustus Dodson) 26 January 1851; marr. at Brattleby, co. Lincoln (by the father of the bridegroom, assisted by the Rev. George Elliot), on Tuesday, 22 July 1879, the Rev. Edward Dale Galloway (3rd son of the Rev. William Brown Galloway, Vicar of St. Mark's, Regent's Park, London, by Ellen Jane his wife, eldest dau. of Henry Benning of Barnard Castle, co. Durham, M.R.C.S.); born in London 15 March 1848; of Trinity College, Cambridge, matriculated Michaelmas Term, 1867, B.A. 1872, M.A. 1875; Rector of Papworth Everard, co. Cambridge, March 1879; died on Tuesday, 16 October, bur. in the churchyard at Papworth Everard 19 October 1894. M.I.

Maurice Wright of Wold Newton, co. Lincoln; born at Wold Newton, and bapt. there (by the Rev. John Grantham) 30 December 1792; died at Wold Newton, from the result of an accident, 15 December, bur. there 19 December 1839. Memorial window. Will dated 7 December 1838, with codicil dated 10 June 1839, proved (P.C.C. 383 *Arden*) 28 May 1840, by the Rev. William Wright, one of the Exors named in will. Power reserved to John Wright, brother, the Exor named in codicil. *Portrait in oils at Wold Newton, in the possession of William Maurice Wright, his grandson.*



Elizabeth, dau. of Wright Mason of Coningsby, co. Lincoln, by Dorothy Murton his wife; born at Coningsby 19 April 1806, and bapt. there; marr. at Coningsby 31 October 1827; died at Binbrooke Hall, co. Lincoln, on Saturday, 7 January, bur. at Wold Newton 12 January 1871. Memorial window. Admon was granted at the Principal Registry 28 February 1871, to William Wright of Wold Newton, son, one of the next of kin.

Eliza Mason, born at Wold Newton 8 November, bapt. there 9 November 1828; marr. by licence at Wold Newton 29 October 1850, Robert Walton Drake of Dircarr House, near Wakefield, co. York (only son of Robert Drake of Wakefield, by Ann Eyre his wife, dau. of Pearson Walton of Walton, co. York); born at Wakefield on Thursday, 7 February 1822; died s.p. at Keswick, co. Cumberland, 10 July, bur. at Sandal, co. York, 14 July 1852. She died at Binbrooke Hall 3 April, and was bur. at Wold Newton 5 April 1884. Memorial window. Will dated 7 October 1879, proved at Lincoln 17 May 1884, by Mary Wright of Binbrooke Hall, spinster, sister, the sole Executrix.

Mary, born at Wold Newton 6 July, bapt. there (by the Rev. H. W. Powell) 11 July 1830; died unmarried at Binbrooke Hall 12 September, bur. at Wold Newton 15 September 1885. Memorial window. Will dated 1 May 1884, proved at Lincoln 1 October 1885, by Charles Manby Nainby of Barnoldby-le-Beck, co. Lincoln, and William Martin Caswell of North Ormsby, co. Lincoln, the Exors.

B

Richard Caldicott Wright, born at Haugh, co. Lincoln, 3 January 1852, and bapt. there (by the Rev. Paul Augustus Dodson) the next day; educated at King Edward VI. School, Louth; Tea Planter in Ceylon 1874-97, and in Java 1898-1904.

Maurice Wright, born at Haugh 1 September, bapt. there (by the Rev. Paul Augustus Dodson) 3 September 1854; educated at Louth and at Christ's College, Finchley; entered the Army as Lieutenant 19th (Princess of Wales' Own) Hussars 29 November 1876, Captain 11 November 1884, Captain Reserve of Officers 11 November 1884, retired 1891; served in Nile Expedition 1884-85, at battle of Abu-Klea and march from Wady-Halfa; died at Louth, aged 43, on Thursday, 5 May, bur. in the cemetery at Louth 7 May 1898. Admon was granted at Lincoln 21 December 1898, to Thomas Wright, gent.

Thomas Wright of "Ivy Dene," North Thoresby, co. Lincoln; born at Haugh 7 December, bapt. there (by the Rev. Paul Augustus Dodson) 13 December 1857; educated at Louth and at St. Peter's, York. Annie Rosa, dau. of Henry Joseph Bethinson of Balderton, co. Nottingham, by Mary Ann his wife, dau. of William Long of Cranwell Lodge, near Sleaford, co. Lincoln; born at Balderton 8 April 1854, and bapt. at Wyham, co. Lincoln; married at Riby, co. Lincoln, 7 April 1886.

Margaret, born at Wold Newton, co. Lincoln, 30 August 1794, and bapt. there the next day; marr. by licence at Binbrooke, co. Lincoln (by the Rev. John Parkinson, D.C.L.), 21 June 1832, the Rev. Samuel Turner (only son of Dr. Samuel Turner of Caistor, co. Lincoln, by Mary his wife, dau. of John Harnew Swan of Hundon Manor, Caistor); born at Caistor 1 March 1797, and bapt. there; of University College, Oxford, matriculated 29 March 1816, aged 19, B.A. 1820, M.A. 1822; Rector of Nettleton and Vicar of Cadney, both co. Lincoln, 1823 until his death, Chaplain to the Earl of Yarborough; died at Nettleton, aged 80, on Tuesday, 1 May, bur. there 5 May 1877. Will dated 17 July 1867, with three codicils dated respectively 26 April 1873, 29 January 1876 and 21 April 1877, proved (Prin. Reg., 610, 77) 2 July 1877, by Margaret Turner of Nettleton, relict, and Samuel Wright Wright of Brattleby Hall, co. Lincoln, son, two of the Exors. *Portrait in oils at Nettleton House, Caistor, in the possession of the Rev. Arthur Samuel Wright, his grandson.* She died at Nettleton House, Caistor, in her 101st year, on Sunday, 23 December, and was bur. at Nettleton 27 December 1894. M.I. *Portrait in oils at Nettleton House, Caistor, in the possession of the Rev. Arthur Samuel Wright, and another at Brattleby Hall in the possession of Philip Chetwood Wright, her grandsons.*

Reg., 1040, 79) 23 December 1879, by John Hyde Bell of Louth, co. Lincoln, and Charles Manby Nainby of Barnoldby-le-Beck, co.
